#### A. Trust in God's Word

 "Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them."
 Joshua 1:6

### B. Obey God's Word

 "Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go."
 Joshua 1:7

# II. Keys to Release the Power of God's Word

## A. Need to Speak it

- "This Book of the Law shall not depart (forgotten) from your mouth."
   Joshua 1:8a
- "The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit." Proverbs 18:21

#### B. Meditate on it

- 1. "but you shall meditate in it..."

  Joshua 1:8b
- 2. Hebrew word: 737 "hagah"
  - a) "murmur, ponder, imagine, mutter, speak, study, talk, or utter"
  - b) First character: 7 means: "look, to behold, to reveal or experience"
  - c) Middle character:  $\lambda$  means: "to chew on, or the moving of the mouth" as in the word: ruminant
- 3. Ruminate: means "to think deeply about something; to go over in the mind repeatedly and often casually or slowly".
- 4. Constantly: "day and night".

- 5. Caution about Priorities: Beware of Life's Busyness...
  - a) Worship precedes service: "Worship the Lord your God, and serve only him."
     Luke 4:8
  - b) Not Visa Versa: "For he served Baal, and worshipped him."1 Kings 22:53

### C. Obey what God's Word says.. i.e. Apply it to your life.

1. "that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it." Joshua 1:8c

- 2. Not success as today's world views it, but you will exhibit prudence.
